

Short tour description/track characteristics: Besides spectacular curve combinations, the focus of this lap is clearly on the landscape. The Grödnerjoch and the Sella Pass are the start of the tour - 2 passes that are great both in terms of driving and scenery! Via Canazei we go in the direction of the Karer Pass. At the Karer lake a stopover is announced. The scenery of the Latemar group reflected in the lake is impressive. A short way back it goes then over the Nigerpass (along the Rosengarten) to Kastelruth. Also here the landscape is clearly in the foreground. From Castelrotto downhill to Waidbruck and then again in wonderful curve combinations steeply uphill to Lajen, in order to take the panoramic high trail to Gufidaun. From there into the Vilnöss valley, the path leads up to the Würzjoch. This pass is quite narrow from this side, but simply wonderful to ride. Via the Badertal it goes back to St. Kassian.
